**CUSTOMS NOTICE**

**New Processing Fees for Private Aircraft**  
**Effective 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013**

***Customs Regulations 147***

**Processing Fee – All Bahamas Airports**

- **Commercial Aircraft** – classified as an aircraft that is being piloted by someone that is being paid to fly it. It does not matter if it is not for charter. (C-7) Charges will be \$75.00 inbound and \$75.00 outbound.
- **Private Aircraft** – classified as an aircraft operated for pleasure and recreation only piloted by a pilot who is not flying for reward or remuneration or for business purposes. (C-7A) Charge will be \$50.00 inbound.

**Customs Attendance Fee – MYNN**

- Any aircraft arriving between the hours of 1701 - 0859 will pay a customs attendance fee of \$50.00.

**Customs Attendance Fee – All Family Island Airports**

- Any aircraft arriving between the hours of 1701 - 0859 will pay a customs attendance fee of \$50.00 per hour per officer.
